The Environment Agency has granted the application by **Manchester Paper Plastic Ltd** for registration as an exporter of **Plastic** packaging waste, under the Producer Responsibility Obligations (Packaging and Packaging Waste) Regulations 2024 ('the Regulations').

The registration will commence on **29 June 2026** and remain valid unless notified in writing by the Environment Agency.

This registration only applies to the above named operator and material. If the legal entity changes, the new legal entity will have to make a new application for registration.

You must notify the Environment Agency immediately in writing of any changes to the details submitted in your application.

Under Regulation 87(3)(c) the Environment Agency has approved the version of your Sampling and Inspection Plan submitted under Regulation 86(4)(c) on **25 June 2026**. If you wish to vary your plan, you must operate in accordance with the approved plan until the Environment Agency notifies you that the amended plan has been approved.

Conditions of registration

You must comply with the conditions of registration in **Regulation 88** and the reporting requirements in **Regulation 91** and **Schedule 8** of the Regulations. Failure to do so may lead to the cancellation of your registration and/or enforcement action.

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Notes:

The Environment Agency has a duty to monitor compliance with your registration under the Regulations.

The Environment Agency has the power to cancel your registration under Regulation 90 if it appears to us that:

- (1) you are in breach of any of the conditions of registration.
- (2) you knowingly or recklessly supplied information which is false or misleading in your application for registration.
- (3) knowingly or recklessly supplied information which is false or misleading in connection with compliance with any of the conditions of registration.
- (4) one of the circumstances in Regulation 90(2) applies, such as you have died, become incapacitated or ceased trading.

Please note that a cancellation notice may be sent to you without prior warning.

The Environment Agency may also take enforcement action in accordance with our Enforcement and Sanctions Policy. This may include the imposition of a civil sanction under Regulation 121 and Schedule 13 of the Regulations, or criminal sanctions for offences under Regulations 117 and 118.
